

The Future of Renewable Energy: Floating Solar Farms!



Floating solar farms are a new and effective development in eco-friendly technology that utilise lakes and oceans to host solar panels. They produce up to 20% more energy compared to normal solar panels on land as they are able to track the sun throughout the day, allowing them to catch more sunlight.

Not only do floating solar farms have a less significant impact on the environment, they also save space and conserve water. They are also cost-effective which is what makes them such a great choice for producing renewable energy.

Last summer, the largest floating solar panel farm on a dam, was completed in Portugal. Two tugboats were used to move 12,000 solar panels into position on Portugal's Alqueva reservoir last July, and this is just the start...

As the world continually seeks to become a more environmentally friendly, sustainable planet, floating solar farms are set to become far more popular. They are considered instrumental in the fight to create more clean, renewable energy, whilst reducing the number of harmful emissions generated from more traditional means of generating energy, such as the burning of fossil fuels.

The largest floating solar farm in Europe is the 6.3MW farm on the Queen Elizabeth II Reservoir by London with more than 23,000 solar panels.



Book Review - Wonder




The book Wonder is a relatable and inspiring novel about a young boy who is represented as different from others due to his disability.

St Mary's Stadium in Southampton is Archaeological Gold Mine!

Something you may not know, is that Southampton (and the surrounding area) is home to some fascinating archaeological finds.

St Mary's Stadium

One of Southampton's most popular and iconic places, St Mary's Stadium, the home of Southampton FC, is also an archaeological hot-spot, with recent discoveries including old weapons, gold and jewellery. These exciting finds date back to the 7th century (that's 1,400 years ago) and the development of Hamwic, the Anglo-Saxon market and port which later gave its name to Hampshire.

The items unearthed at the popular site include two glass and amber necklaces, pottery, gold thread and copper utensils. The excavation of these interesting relics took place right underneath the stands of the stadium, which means that the rest of it has been left undisturbed.

Anglo-Saxon Hampshire

Hampshire has rich Anglo-Saxon history. Hamwic was set to become a prestigious and important area of trade and occupation in the early Anglo-Saxon period. Evidence of manufacturing has shown up all over the district, with things like tools, copper, textile & leather work and iron being frequently found. This site has also been home to more findings of Anglo-Saxon coins than any other site in Britain; it is evident that today's Southampton was a place of advanced crafting and gathering skills.
