#### Be there.

# Spellings and vocabulary

At Crestwood, we aim to equip all students with the vocabulary that they need to access the world around them, understand texts and articulate themselves clearly.

Vocabulary plays a **fundamental role** in the reading process and is critical to reading comprehension. Students will learn the meanings of most words indirectly, through everyday experiences with oral and written language. Other words are learned through carefully designed instruction - these are the words we are focusing on through our vocabulary lists.

# Strategies for **definitions**

Students remember word meanings better when they can connect new meanings to knowledge that they already have. This type of processing or "link" occurs when the are doing activities such as the following:

- Looking for antonyms and synonyms (similar and opposite meanings)
- Rewriting definitions for different levels (for a toddler, for a primary age child, for a peer, for an adult)
- Looking at images and identifying whether it is an appropriate example of the word
- Creating sentences that include the new word
- Creating scenarios or stories that include the new word

Each of the tasks outlined above reinforces both the definition and the contextual knowledge of the word.



#### **Deterrent:** A thing that is intended to discourage someone from doing something.
















