Key Messages:

- Week 2 Menu 2 here
- We are experiencing difficulties along Cherbourg Road, outside the school at the start and end of each day with parents not conforming to parking regulations.. Eastleigh BC are sending Traffic Officers to police the area, due to local resident complaints and parents are at risk of getting fined. Our ultimate concern is for the safety of our students. Can we remind you that:
 - You must not park on the yellow zig zag lines outside the school
 - You must not park across entrances to the school or college
 - Please park in the marked bays
 - Please be careful of your speed and keep below 20mph
 - Do not block oncoming traffic whilst you wait for your child to get to your car
- The new summer top has been launched and it is lovely seeing some students wearing it. Until the weather improves and the rule is relaxed, the red top is **to be worn with the blazer**.
- Please can you ensure that your child does not have false nails for school and that the only jewellery they wear is a pair of stud earrings and a watch. Far too many girls are coming in with expensive pandora bracelets, rings, nose studs and false nails. We do allow students to wear a retainer but not a nose stud, please ensure your child adheres to this.
- Students in all year groups are starting to wear **grey school jumpers** as an alternative to the red. We have noticed that not all the grey jumpers being worn are school jumpers. Please note that **jumpers should be dark grey v-neck wool/wool-mix school jumpers or cardigans**, school-logoed or plain (logoed available from Skoolkit; plain can be purchased from any school clothing retailer as long as the colour matches).
