There is no time to waste, we want you to be more prepared and in a better position than you are right now.

# What can you do to help prepare you?

1. **Think positively about revision.** If you hold negative thoughts about revision it makes the process harder to do or begin in the first place.
2. **Have a plan.** Knowing what you're going to do, when you are going to do it makes it so much easier to get on with it.
3. **Take ownership.** Find out what you need to revise, find out what works for you, seek out help when you need it.
4. **Remember that the the ability to learn, and revise can be developed.** No one is born as the finished article.
5. **Believe that it is possible.**

# What can parents do to help prepare you?

- **Remember that they are an individual** - We need to help them to find what works for them.
- **Positivity and Encouragement** - The purpose of the mocks is a learning experience to help prepare your child now and for the future.
- **Learning Environment** - A space? Phone? Distractions? Structured Time?
- **Supporting with Balance** - Are they still getting enough time for themselves? For commitments? Rewards? Sleeping and Eating as well as possible?
