## **Uniform:**

Please take the opportunity over the Easter break to make sure that your child has the correct uniform for next term. Please note -

- The new Summer top is now available to purchase from Skoolkit in the shop and online (<u>here</u>). This top is not compulsory.
- The options are that students can wear this top with grey school trousers, skirt, skort or tailored shorts, under their blazer for the Summer term.
- Alternatively they can wear a white shirt and tie if they prefer. Short sleeved white shirts are acceptable and some students may find this a cooler option and cheaper for parents.
- Students will be required to wear their blazers over whichever option they choose.
- As we have done in the past, when the temperatures rise we will allow students to remove ties and blazers.
- We suggest students wear their blazers to school as they have always done and they will then be allowed to remove them when given permission in school.
- If we have a long period of hot weather we will inform students and parents that ties
  and blazers will not be required. This will be done via our usual channels and a start
  and end date will be given. PE kits will not be acceptable for school as an alternative
  to the above.
- We have also introduced a dark grey v necked school jumper for all year groups (logoed or plain) and students can commence wearing this with immediate effect.
