A REMINDER FROM SEPTEMBER 2026 THE UNIFORM WILL BE:

- Red logoed polo - Year 7 - 9
- Black logoed polo - Year 10 - 11
- Grey logoed V neck sweatshirt
- Students can still wear the existing uniform for the academic year 2026/27
- Year 11 will still receive a tie in their first assembly if they require one
- Please can parents be firm about nose studs and jewellery
 - The only permitted jewellery is a watch and ONE pair of STUD earrings.
 - Students can wear a flat, transparent, retainer in their nose, but not a nose stud.
 - If the rules continue to be broken we will revert to not allowing nose studs or retainers.
 - Parents allowing their child to get their nose pierced should do so where there is a sufficient period of time for the nose to heal. The minimum time required is 6 weeks and therefore as a result the only time piercings should be done are in the summer break.
